An Ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles changing and establishing the name of a certain street in the City of Los Angeles.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the name of that certain street (being the first street northwesterly of North Broadway) extending from Sunset Boulevard to its terminus northerly of College Street, heretofore unnamed or known as or called

**CALLE DEL TORO,
BULL STREET,
TORO STREET,
CASTELLAR STREET,**

or
CASTELLAR STREET,

or any portion of which may be or may have been heretofore unnamed or known as or called Calle del Toro, Bull Street, Toro Street, Castellar Street or Castelar Street, be and the same is hereby changed to and established as

CASTELLAR STREET

Sec. 2. The streets referred to in this ordinance are public streets in the City of Los Angeles as it existed prior to the consolidation of the cities of Los Angeles and San Pedro.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in The Los Angeles Daily Journal.
